## WELCOME TO THE 1994 HOCKEY SEASON

In particular, we at the Glebe District Hockey Club welcome all those NEW Junior players who have joined us in 1994. We trust that you have a rewarding and enjoyable year. We know that your parents will find the Clubhouse a hospitable place, and that they will take the opportunity to meet other parents, especially those involved with your team.

Welcome to our MINKEY players. We trust that you find your involvement in Minkey a fun time, as well as a useful introduction to the skills of Hockey.

To all those players and their families who have backed up for another year, it is great to see you all again. You are the backbone of the Club.

Please retain this issue! It contains all the information you will need for the entire season - the Competition Draw and the list of Contact Persons (Coaches and Managers).

## TEN RULES FOR HAVING A GOOD SEASON

1. *Play for the fun of it, not just to please your parents or the coach.*
2. *Play by the rules of the game.*
3. *Accept the referee's decisions with grace.*
4. *Don't mouth off! Your team mates will play better if you encourage them and applaud their good play. Constant criticism by fellow players ruins the morale of a team, and makes for worse play, not better.*
5. *Work hard to develop team understanding, both on and off the field.*
6. *Be a good sport. Applaud all good play, whether by your team or an opponent. Thank the opposition after the game. Without them, there would be no game.*
7. *Don't be a show-off or a bully. Don't try to take all the free hits. Show confidence in your team mates by sharing responsibilities.*
8. *Listen to the coach. Try to put his or her advice into practice.*
9. *Turn up to training. You will enjoy the game more if you can see a steady improvement in your skills. It is also an excellent way of showing support for your team mates.*
10. *Don't blame other players, especially the goal keeper, when a goal is scored against you. Get on with the game. Be positive. Try to lift your own and the team's performance, not criticise others.*

## EQUIPMENT REQUIRED BY COMPETITION PLAYERS

We remind all new players in COMPETITION TEAMS that they need to obtain their own equipment - hockey stick, mouthguard, white shorts, maroon and white (Manly League) socks, Glebe maroon shirt, shinpads and shoes. Most of these can be obtained at the Clubhouse.

Note that boots with sprigs cannot be worn on synthetic TURF surfaces, but are often used by players on grass surfaces. You need flat surface shoes (sandshoes, joggers) on the synthetic turf surfaces.

**ABOVE ALL, DON'T FORGET YOUR MOUTHGUARD.**

It is also a good idea to make sure that your name is clearly displayed on your hockey stick.

## MINKEY PLAYERS

Minkey commences at 10.00 a.m. each Saturday and runs for about an hour.

Minkey players should have adequate footwear, but do not require any special clothing or protective gear. The Club has some sticks for Minkey players; however, since the number of Minkey players seems to just keep growing, it might be a good idea to purchase a hockey stick, if possible. Minkey players can then use it at home!

Junior hockey sticks are relatively inexpensive - you should be able to purchase one for around \$20. See Jim Oman if you wish to purchase a hockey stick.

## TIMES OF GAMES

The usual times for games are as follows:

Under 17:	8.00 a.m.
Under 15:	10.20 a.m.
Under 13:	9.15 a.m.
Under 11:	11.25 a.m.

(Under 13's and Under 15's play 30 minutes each way; Under 11's play 25 minutes each way).

(Sometimes changes have to be made. This year's Draw seems to contain a lot of variations on these times. Please check with your team manager each week. Times on synthetic turf surfaces, in particular, may vary.)

## TRANSPORT

For away games, we need a minimum of THREE cars to take players to the game. Ideally, we would like everyone to help out at some stage in the season. Transport is not something that should be left to the same few parents each time there is an away game.

If everyone helped with transport, then an individual would need to help out two or three times a season.

For away games, we normally meet at the Clubhouse about an hour before the game is due to start. After the game, players are then returned to their homes if they live close, or to the Clubhouse if they live some distance away.

Please check transport details for away games with the team manager.

Players who live some distance away from Glebe often go directly to the ground instead of coming to the Clubhouse. Again, please let the team manager know.

Players should warm up before a game, so all players should be at the ground (home or away) at least twenty minutes before the game starts. Proper warm-ups help prevent injury, and, of course, improve performance.

## LOCATIONS

### MOOREBANK TURF AND GRASS Ernie Smith Reserve (MOOREBANK/LIVERPOOL CLUB) Junction Street, Moorebank

Routes: EITHER Coming from Sydney via Canterbury Road, turn left into King Georges Road and take M5 tollway (\$2) as far as Heathcote Road off ramp (just past toll booths), turn right at top of ramp and then right at Junction Road. Be careful not to turn right at top of ramp and go back on tollway!

OR follow Canterbury Road right rough-it will become Milperra Road and then Newbridge Road; turn left off Newbridge into Nuwarra Road and right into Junction Road.

\*This is a turf surface and no football boots allowed.

### THE CREST at Georges Hall (BANKSTOWN CLUB)

Route: Car park is in Mount Street, which runs off Carysfield, which runs off Johnson Street, which runs off the Hume Highway.

\*This is a turf surface and no football boots are allowed.

## SUTHERLAND TURF AND GRASS Sylvania Reserve, off Sylvania Road Nor. (SUTHERLAND CLUB)

Route: Princes Highway; left into Box Road, then right into Sylvania Road Nor, right into car park, near overhead high voltage power lines (or left into Garnet Street, then left again into Sylvania Road Nor.

\*This is a turf surface.

## GARDINERS Wolli Creek Road and Gardiner Road, Arncliffe. (ST GEORGE CLUB)

Route: Princes Highway, right into Forest Road, left into Wolli Creek Road, left again into Gardiner Road.

## HEFFRON Heffron Park, Jersey Road, Matraville. (RANDWICK CLUB)

Route: Cleveland Street, Anzac Parade, Bunnerong Road, then left into Jersey Road.

## GLEBE CLUB HOME GAMES

These may be on Jubilee Oval OR on Federal Park (on the other side of the canal).

## CARNIVALS

In addition to the competition games, Glebe Hockey Club enters Junior teams in Carnivals. Some teams will have already played in the Northern Districts Carnival, which we use as a warm-up to the Premiership. In the middle of the season, sometime in June, we enter teams in the St George Carnival, and towards the end of the season, we enter teams in the Lithgow Hornets Carnival. Carnivals are held on Sundays.

We encourage players to take part in these Carnivals, as they are a fun time for all, and also a time when the whole Club can get together. However, we appreciate that not everyone can get to the Carnivals because of other commitments. The Age Convenors (Ron Cheong and Chris O'Connor - Under 11; Mick Tapsell - Under 13; and Gary Cronin - Under 15) are responsible for organising teams for the Carnivals.

St George Carnival at Gardiners Park in June and the Lithgow Hornets Carnival at Lithgow in August.

Dates will be published in the Red Rag when they become available.

## TRAINING

Training for the Under 11 and Under 13 teams is on Wednesday afternoons at 4.45 p.m. Training usually concludes by 6.00 p.m.

Training for the Under 15 teams is usually at Homebush each Thursday evening. Players are also welcome to

train with the women's teams of a Wednesday evening at Jubilee at 6.30 p.m. If they are unable to train at Homebush on Thursday. Under 15 players - please check with your coaches for exact training details.

While we realise that, for various reasons, players cannot always attend training, there is no doubt that the "regulars" who train improve their skills at a faster rate than those who don't come to training. Hockey is a game that requires a high degree of skill if you are to maximise your enjoyment of it. So be a "regular" even when the weather turns cold!

## JUNIOR TEAMS MANAGERS AND COACHES

We Have a manager to relieve the coach of some of the burden of running the team. The manager looks after organisational matters, especially transport, so the coach can concentrate on coaching.
