#### Players' Code

#### 10 Rules for a Good Season

1. *Play for the fun of it, not just to please your parents or the coach.*
2. *Play by the rules of the game.*
3. *Accept the referee's decisions with grace.*
4. *Don't mouth off! Your team mates will play better if you encourage them and applaud their good play. Constant criticism by fellow players ruins the morale of a team, and makes for worse play, not better.*
5. *Work hard to develop team understanding, both on and off the field.*
6. *Be a good sport. Applaud all good play, whether by your team or an opponent. Thank the opposition after the game. Without them, there would be no game.*
7. *Don't be a show-off or a bully. Don't try to take all the free hits. Show confidence in your team mates by sharing responsibilities.*
8. *Listen to the coach. Try to put his or her advice into practice.*
9. *Turn up to training. You will enjoy the game more if you can see a steady improvement in your skills. It is also an excellent way of showing support for your team mates.*
10. *Don't blame other players, especially the goal keeper, when a goal is scored against you. Get on with the game. Be positive. Try to lift your own and the team's performance, not criticise others.*

## Equipment Required by Competition Players

We remind all new players in COMPETITION TEAMS that they need to obtain their own equipment - hockey stick, mouthguard, white shorts, maroon and white (Manly League) socks, Glebe maroon shirt, shinpads and shoes. Most of these can be obtained at the Clubhouse.

Note that boots with sprigs cannot be worn on synthetic TURF surfaces, but are often used by players on grass surfaces. You need flat surface shoes (sandshoes, joggers or special turf shoes) on the synthetic turf surfaces.

It is also a good idea to make sure that your name is clearly displayed on your hockey stick.

## Times of Games

The usual times for games are as follows:

Under 15: 10.20 a.m.

Under 13: 9.15 a.m.

Under 11: 11.20 a.m.

Under 15's play 30 minutes each way

Under 13's play 30 minutes each way

Under 11's play 25 minutes each way

Sometimes changes have to be made. Please check with your team manager each week. Times on synthetic turf surfaces, in particular, may vary.

Players should warm up before a game, so all players should be at the ground (home or away) at least twenty minutes before the game starts. Proper warm-ups help prevent injury, and, of course, improve performance.

## Transport

For away games, we need a minimum of THREE cars to take players to the game. Ideally, we would like everyone to help out at some stage in the season. Transport is not something that should be left to the same few parents each away game.

If everyone helped with transport, then an individual would need to help out two or three times a season.

For away games, we normally meet at the Clubhouse about an hour before the game is due to start.

After the game, players are then returned to their homes if they live close to Jubilee Park, or to the Clubhouse if they live some distance away.

Please check transport details for away games with the team manager.

Players who live some distance away from Glebe often go directly to the ground instead of coming to the Clubhouse.

Whatever means you decide to use, please let the team manager know so that we know how all team members will get to an away game.

## Carnivals

In addition to the competition games, Glebe Hockey Club enters Junior teams in Carnivals. Some teams will have already played in the Northern Districts Carnival and the Bankstown Carnival, which we used as a warm-up to the Premiership. In the middle of the season, 18 June, we enter teams in the St George Carnival, and on 20 August we enter teams in the Lithgow Hornets Carnival. Carnivals are held on Sundays.

We encourage players to take part in these Carnivals, as they are a fun time for all, and also a time when the whole Club can get together. However, we appreciate that not everyone can get to the Carnivals because of other commitments.

Kelth Harvey and Team Coaches & Managers are responsible for organising teams for the Carnivals.

Routes: EITHER Coming from Sydney via Canterbury Road, turn left into King Georges Road and take M5 tollway (\$2) as far as Heathcote Road off ramp (just past toll booths), turn right at top of ramp and then right at Junction Road. Be careful not to turn right at top of ramp and go back on tollway!

OR follow Canterbury Road right through — It will become Millperra Road and then Newbridge Road; turn left off Newbridge into Nuwarra Road and right into Junction Road.

\*This is a turf surface and no football boots allowed.

### The Crest

Mount Street at Georges Hall  
(Bankstown Club)

Route: Car park is in Mount Street, which runs off Carysfield, which runs off Johnson Street, which runs off the Hume Highway.

### Sutherland Turf & Grass

Sylvania Reserve,  
off Sylvania Road Nor.  
(Sutherland Club)

Route: Princes Highway; left into Box Road, then right into Sylvania Road Nor, right into car park, near overhead high voltage power lines (or left into Garnet Street, then left again into Sylvania Road Nor.

\*This is a turf surface.

### Gardiner

Cnr. Woll Creek Road and Gardiner Road, Arncliffe. (St George Club)

Route: Princes Highway, right into Forest Road, left into Woll Creek Road, left again into Gardiner Road.

### Heffron

Heffron Park, Jersey Road, Matraville.  
(Randwick Club)

Route: Anzac Parade, Bunnerong Road, then left into Jersey Road.

### Uni of NSW

Little Bay Sporting Complex  
1408 Anzac Parade, Little Bay  
(Eastern Suburbs Club)

Route: Anzac Parade, through Randwick to Little Bay.

### Parramatta

Dan Mahoney Oval  
Gladstone Street, Nth Parramatta  
(Parramatta Club)

Route: Along Victoria Road, past James Rouse Drive and right at Brabyn Street, then second left.

### A REMINDER...

### NEED HOCKEY EQUIPMENT? ...

As well as Club shirts and socks and equipment available from our Equipment Officer, Ron Cheong, Glebe Hockey has an arrangement with Daimer Sports at Homebush.
