For Minkey families and U9 teams, the social membership is \$50

Please note, the Club Family Social Membership payable to the Glebe District Hockey Club is a fee per family, not per child.

6. Complete registration and payment to Sydney East Hockey Association (SEHA) and Hockey NSW (page 5)

- U13 – Players aged 11 or 12 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017
- U15 – Players aged 13 or 14 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017
- U17 – Players aged 15 or 16 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017

<p align="center"><b>Players Code of Conduct</b></p>	<p align="center"><b>Spectators Code of Conduct</b></p>
<p>As a player selected by the Glebe District Hockey Club (GDHC) you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any competition or activity held or sanctioned by the GDHC whilst in any role you hold as a player.</p> <p>The Management Committee of the GDHC is responsible for ensuring that the Code of Conduct is met at all times. If, in the opinion of the Committee and in accordance with the GDHC Constitution, there is a serious breach of the Code of Conduct the player may be suspended from further participation.</p> <p><b>In accepting selection in a GDHC team, the player agrees to:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Behave in a sportsmanlike manner at all times to other players, officials and spectators.</li> <li>Make no detrimental statements in public in respect of the performance of any match officials, umpires, competitors, coaches or spectators in any of the competitions in which the GDHC participates.</li> <li>Play by the rules at all times and ensure that the game of hockey is not brought into disrepute.</li> <li>Accept responsibility for all actions taken. You will exercise reasonable care to prevent injury by ensuring that you play within the rules. You understand that reasonable care consists of showing due diligence in abiding by the rules and adhering to the officials' decisions.</li> <li>Not engage in any doping practice, the use of drugs or other banned or prohibited substance unless prescribed by a medical doctor and adhere to the Anti-Doping Policy advocated by Hockey Australia.</li> <li>Not bet on the outcome or on any other aspect of a hockey match or competition.</li> <li>Not throw or fix a match, try to achieve a contrived outcome to a match or competition, or otherwise influence improperly the outcome or any other aspect of a match or a competition.</li> <li>Not show unnecessary obvious dissension, displeasure or disapproval towards an umpire, technical official, tournament director or other association or competition official as a consequence of his or her decision or generally.</li> <li>Abstain from the use of tobacco and the consumption of alcoholic beverages when playing.</li> <li>Refrain from harassment of any kind towards other players and officials and treat all participants fairly and within the context of their sporting activities, regardless of gender, race, place of origin, athletic potential, colour, sexual orientation, religion, political beliefs, socio-economic status and other conditions.</li> <li>Not do anything which adversely affects or reflects on or discredits the game of hockey, Hockey Australia, any member State Association, the GDHC, or any squad, team, competition, tournament, sponsor, official supplier or licensee, including, but not limited to, any illegal act or any act of dishonesty or fraud.</li> </ol>	<p>As a spectator watching an event that is conducted or sanctioned by any of the Associations to which the Glebe District Hockey Club affiliates, <b>you must meet the following requirements with regard to your conduct:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Spectators are an important part of the game and shall at all times conform to accepted standards of good sportsmanship and behaviour.</li> <li>Spectators shall at all times respect officials, coaches and players and extend courtesies to them.</li> <li>Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and fellow spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.</li> <li>Respect the umpires' decision. Do not abuse, threaten or intimidate an umpire or match official and do not show dissension, displeasure or disapproval towards an umpire or match official's decision in an abusive or unreasonable fashion.</li> <li>Support skilled performances and show respect for opposition teams and players.</li> <li>Display appropriate social behaviour by not using profane, demeaning or derogatory language, or harassing players, coaches, officials other spectators or venue staff.</li> <li>Leave the spectator area tidy and free from litter, do not cause damage to venue fixtures and adhere to parking directions.</li> <li>Under no circumstances bring prohibited substances or alcohol into venues where this is prohibited.</li> <li>Do not ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there for support</li> <li>Acknowledge all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time to enable the conduct of the competition.</li> <li>Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, race, place of origin, colour, sexual orientation, religion, political beliefs, socio-economic status, and other conditions</li> </ol>




### Step 6 of 6 – Registration and Payment to SEHA and Hockey NSW

If you are registering more than one child, please ensure you complete this step individually for each child. Administrative fees such as ground hire and insurance are mandatory and must be paid for prior to any game being played. This registration is compulsory for all of our juniors – including Minkey.

1. Refer to the SEHA website ([www.SEHA.com.au](http://www.SEHA.com.au))
  - a. Click on **Register 2017**, located on the top banner- first option left of screen
  - b. Click on **"For all other SEHA clubs, please register by clicking...."** located on the bottom of the screen

2. Click 'Register' rather than 'Renew' as no information has rolled over to the new system	
3. Choose the relevant 'Registration Type' and click 'next step'	
4. Complete and fill in:	Basic Information, Address, Contact Information + Additional Information
5. Payment	Have a Visa or MasterCard ready to process and complete the payment.
