Mr. Chairman & Gentlemen,

I have great pleasure in presenting for your consideration and adoption the following report of the Club's activity during Season 1942.

With the entry of Japan into hostilities, hockey clubs generally were confronted with many obstacles, which were extremely difficult to overcome.

In this your club was no exception. Many of its prominent players enlisted in the services with the result that we were not always able to field teams at full strength.

The Metropolitan Hockey Association decided to run a gradele competition and 4 teams were entered from your club.

Our 1941 Premiershipe team and Reserve Grade Premiers were evenly graded to form the Glebe "H" team led by Charlie Humphreys and the "Q" team led by Jack Quinlin.

The third team comprised mostly lads having their first season in Hockey while the fourth team was known as Glebe-Balmain and was composed of schoolboys from Glebe and Balmain Police Boys Club. After 4 matches the latter team was withdrawn as the boys were too small to play against grown players.

V. TURNER. Played hockey for the first time and showed good form. He should do even better if his speed off the mark is improved.

K. RYAN. A very useful player who did well before leaving for his "Battle Station". A great team man and tryer.

C. WHITESIDES. A junior player who tries hard and towards the end of the season started to show great improvement.

V. BURTON. Another junior player who is improving rapidly. Should be a very good forward next year. Must learn to tackle back.

J. WORLEY. He only managed to play 2 games. His ability as a player and official was sadly missed.
